Spring Break Camp April 5-9, 2010

Please review these agreements with your child. Both the parent/guardian and child can sign the agreement and turn it in to the directors before the first day of camp (Monday April 5th), or can be mailed along with your registration.

Please help us to maintain our rehearsal and performance spaces by keeping them clean and orderly. Our goal is that each child grow creatively and in their responsibility to themselves, others and the world, learn and grow in their social and communication skills, learn and try new activities and skills, and to have fun!

Our educational and artistic goals are best accomplished if each child and parent understand that the following behavioral expectations will be followed:

- Participate fully in the camp, be on time, prepared and ready to work (preparation will include memorizing lines, learning songs, bringing in shoes and/or other costume pieces or props as requested)
- Follow requests made by the directors, stage manager, and interns
- Cooperate with staff, cast and crew
- Stay in camp rehearsal area- do not wander off
- Name calling will not be tolerated
- Treat everyone with respect

We believe it is important that children learn to manage their own behavior. Our approach to behavior management will be:

- Instruct the child that negative behavior is not appropriate
- Discuss problem with parent and notify both parent and child that further problems would result in dismissal
- Dismissal

If at any time the child presents a danger to him/her self or others the child will be dismissed immediately.
