

Our goal is that each child grow creatively and in their responsibility to themselves, others and the world, learn and grow in their social and communication skills, learn and try new activities and skills, and to have fun!

Our educational and artistic goals are best accomplished if each child and parent/adult understands that the following behavioral expectations will be followed:

- Participate fully in the camp, be on time, prepared and ready to work (preparation may include memorizing lines, learning songs, wearing a mask, social distancing, etc.)
- Cooperate and follow requests made by the directors, assistants, OFT Staff
- Stay in camp rehearsal area--do not wander off
- Help us maintain our rehearsal and performance spaces by keeping them clean and orderly
- Treat everyone with kindness and respect
- Name calling or harassment will not be tolerated

We believe it is important that children learn to manage their own behavior. Our approach to behavior management will be:

- Instruct the child that negative behavior is not appropriate
- Discuss problem with parent and notify both parent and child that further problems would result in dismissal

DISMISSAL

If at any time the child presents a danger to him/her self or others the child will be dismissed immediately.

Healthy Camper Code of Conduct

We are committed to providing a healthy and safe environment at Olympia Family Theater. By enrolling in our education programs, the camper is agreeing to:

- Wear a face covering that covers your nose and mouth. Masks are required inside and outside
- No bandanas or gaiter-style masks please. They should be well fitting and multi-layer.
