

LIABILITY

I agree to indemnify and hold harmless Olympia Family Theater (hereinafter referred to as OFT), its Employees, Agents, Officers, Board Members, Volunteers or any other person against loss or expense, including attorney fees, due to any bodily injury, personal injury or property damage which may result from any and all activities while participating in classes or any other activity sponsored by or conducted by OFT, or while visiting any facilities owned by, leased by, or controlled by OFT.

OFT guarantees that all equipment and facilities are in good repair and are appropriate for the purposes to which they will be put, and personnel are appropriately trained and screened.

This release is recorded through our enrollment database, along with the date of agreement.

COVID-19 RISK

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. By enrolling and participating in Olympia Family Theater's education program, you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19.

TRANSPORTATION

I understand that I am responsible for transporting my child(ren) to and from OFT. I will notify the Education Department in writing if any special arrangements for transportation are being made (i.e. carpools or someone other than you is transporting and signing out your child).

MEDICAL RELEASE

I authorize and consent to medical treatment and procedures deemed immediately necessary and advisable by emergency medical personnel to safeguard my child's health if I cannot be contacted.

CANCELLATION POLICY

- Before programming starts, tuition and enrollment can be transferred to another class or camp, or gift card. Once programming begins, tuition and enrollment cannot be transferred.
- If registration is canceled after it has been processed, but at least TWO WEEKS prior to the programming start date, a full refund will be given.
- If registration is canceled WITHIN TWO WEEKS of the programming start date, a refund of 50% will be given.
- OFT reserves the right to cancel programming. In that case, tuition will be refunded in full.
- In the case of inclement weather, programming will move to a virtual platform. OFT will work with families on a case by case basis to offer up to 50% tuition refund if you choose to cancel enrollment.
- We strive to make sure all students are satisfied with their experience, but if after completing the first day of class and deciding it's not for you, please let us know before the start of the second class and we will work with families on a case by case basis. After the second day of class, no refunds or exchanges can be made.
