OFT EDUCATION MISSION:

OFT is your community partner in raising imaginative, loving, joyful and confident children. Our educational programs provide opportunities for personal development for young people, teaching creativity and responsibility, encouraging teamwork and personal integrity, and fostering self-esteem and appreciation for the performing arts.

Our educational and artistic goals are best accomplished if every family understands that the following behavioral expectations will be followed:

- **Be on time**, and **feel ready to participate** in the program!
- **Follow Directions** given by Teachers and Staff.
- **Stay with the group**, please do not wander off without permission.
- **Be Kind and Respectful** to the Students, Staff, and Classroom Space.

We believe it is important that children learn to manage their own behavior. Our approach to behavior management will be:

- Ask the student how they are feeling, and ask if they understand that their behavior is inappropriate
- Make a plan with the student to remedy the inappropriate behavior, and establish follow-up actions if the behavior is displayed again
- If the behavior continues, student will be removed from the classroom for a short break
- If the behavior is continually repeated, we will notify the parent or guardian.

DISMISSAL

If at any time the child presents a danger to him/her self or others the child will be dismissed immediately.

Healthy Camper Code of Conduct
